## Updated Bishop's Appeal Data Report...

Since the *Appeal* statistics report two weeks ago, I share the following update: 4 new gifts were received and there was one addition to a previous gift for a complete total of \$85.00 received. Our refreshed numbers are. . . To date, 269 out of 898 Cabrini Households have participated in the *Annual Bishop's Appeal* or 30% of our parish households. These 269 households have contributed a total of \$26,647 of our \$35,700 goal or 74.6% of amount needed. Average gift amt. as of this date is \$99.06. Waiting to hear from 629 Cabrini Households (70%) who have not yet made their gift to help the parish meet this financial responsibility. *Large, small or in the middle, each household's participation and gift is important.* Thank you and a God bless you to the 30% of Parish Households who have brought us so far! I hope the remaining 70% can help us wrap things up!?!

## Sewer Saga...

This past week, work was completed on laying new sewer pipe from the front of the church on N. Shamokin Street. This should solve the problem of sewage backup in the church basement. Officials from the local Sewer Authority were most helpful in helping to solve the problem. Although we do not have to pay for the new sewer line on the street, we did have to pay Rotor Rooter for the work they had to do "on our side of the curb" to identify the problems and lay some pipe. That RR bill was \$3,048. Additionally, we will have to pay for the cement patch on the sidewalk. After a deductible, our insurance will only cover a fraction of the bills. It's not a very "glamorous improvement" but a necessary one. Please be generous in your offertory envelopes to help the parish cover this unexpected expense.

**July 3, 2016  
Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**First Reading: Isaiah 66:10-14c**

Isaiah instructs the people of Jerusalem to rejoice, because God would restore her prosperity. The people will better understand God's power through their homeland's restoration.

**Second Reading: Galatians 6:14-18**

Paul describes the sign of the cross of Jesus as all that is significant. Following the old laws is unimportant. Instead, being baptized in Christ and adhering to his ideals is what matters most.

**Gospel: Luke 10:1-12, 17-20**

Jesus sent forth seventy-two disciples to preach his good news, telling them "the harvest is rich, but the workers few." He also gave them detailed instructions on how to act towards the people. Jesus then reminded them not to be happy because of their power over evil, but to rejoice in the salvation they would achieve.
