Just a Whisker Shy of 90%!

That's right, we are literally just a couple of *Bishop's Appeal* gifts away from hitting the **90%** of goal mark!!! Since my last complete *Appeal* report, we received **3** new gifts from Cabrini Households totaling **\$165**. These gifts helped us to reach **89.9%** of our 2016 *Appeal* assessment goal. Here's where we currently stand:

- 339 Cabrini Households have participated or 37.8% of parish (339/898);
- Average gift to date is **\$94.63** (\$32,082/336);
- 559 Cabrini Households have yet to respond or 62.2% (559/898) of the Cabrini Parish membership and who could certainly help us reach our goal!;
- \$32,082 has been raised or 89.9% (\$32,082/\$35,700) of goal.

Sincere thanks to each of the 339 Cabrini Households who have helped us come "whisker close" to the 90% mark of our 2016 goal. These Cabrini Households have done such a fine job with their participation/gifts! With just a few weeks left to close the 2016 Appeal books, I call upon those 559 Cabrini Households (almost twothirds of the parish) to join with your fellow parishioners to help the parish meet its stewardship responsibility to the Diocese. Households who choose not to participate hurt the Parish in the long run because we have to divert regular and fund-raising income to cover the Appeal shortfall. Only \$3,618 remains to reach our target. Spread out between 559 not-yetparticipating households. . . it's certainly an achievable goal! The books close on the 2016 Bishop's Appeal at the end of December. If you haven't already done so, please make your gift as soon as possible so the parish will receive credit before the year closes. bookkeeping purposes, make your gift before Christmas to allow for complete processing in December. We will acknowledge and thank all those Cabrini Households who participated via a printed report in the New Year.

Large, small or in the middle... every household's gift and participation is important to Appeal's success. Group of 559, make your contribution, help close the Appeal and put me out of this reporting job. Thanks all! Fr. Martin


