2017 - Bishop's Lenten Appeal Report

Great News! Since our last report, our statistics jumped significantly. As of this bulletin, I am pleased to report our current standing:

- Received to date: **\$20,230.00, 55.9%** of goal (\$20,230/\$36,200);
- **183** Cabrini Households participating **20.6%** of Parish (183/890);
- Average gift stands at **\$110.54**;
- Awaiting response from **707** or **79%** of the parish's households;
- **\$15,970** is needed to meet our goal.

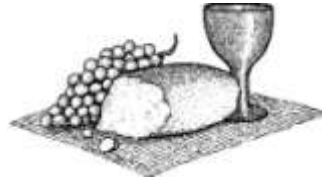
Special thanks and blessings to the "Group of 183" who have brought us beyond our half way point! "Group of 707," we hope to hear from you!?!)

Third Sunday of Easter

First Reading: Acts 2:14, 22-33

After the Holy Spirit descends upon the apostles, Peter preaches with great enthusiasm to both Jews and Christians. He recalls for them in vivid terms the miracles and wonders that Jesus performed.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 1:17-21

Peter makes reference to the Passover, when the Jews escaped from Egypt because the blood of the paschal lamb was shed. Now they are being saved from sin by the blood of Christ, the Lamb of the New Testament.

Gospel: Luke 24:13-35

Jesus reveals Himself to two disciples on the way to Emmaus. After explaining to them the passages in Scripture which referred to Him, Christ "took bread, broke it, and distributed it to them." Then they recognized Christ and their "hearts burned within them."

First Friday Mass for Homeschooling Families
