Lenten Appeal Update. . .

This is an “off week” for reporting our Lenten *Appeal* Update. The information below is our *Appeal* status as of May 12th.

- Recently received, **11** new gifts totaling \$595;
- Received to date: **\$20,825.00** or **57.5%** of goal (**\$20,825/\$36,200**);
- **194** Cabrini Households participating, or **21.8%** of Parish Households (**194/890**);
- Average gift stands at **\$107.35**;
- Awaiting response from **696** or **78%** of the parish!;
- **\$15,375** is needed to meet our Parish goal amount.
