Lenten Appeal Update. . . 208 have. . . 682 are still contemplating. . .

Yes, it's true. . . **208** Cabrini Parish Households have contributed to the '17 Bishop's Appeal. We are eagerly awaiting to hear from the remaining **682** Cabrini Parish Households to help us meet our fiscal stewardship to the Harrisburg Diocese. The good news thus far is as follows (as of May 23, '17):

- **14** new gifts received, totaling **\$1,840**, since the last report;
- Total received to date: **\$22,665**, **62.6%** of goal (\$22,665/\$36,200);
- **208** Cabrini Households participating or **23.4%** of Parish (208/890);
- Average gift stands at **\$109.96**;
- Awaiting response from **682** or **76%** of the parish's households;
- **\$13,535** is needed to meet our goal.

Special thanks and blessings to the wonderful "**Gang of 208**" who have brought us to almost two-thirds of our goal amount. "**Gang of 682**," help us wrap up the appeal with your contribution to the final third of our goal amount!?!? I hope I hear from you!?!?

Updated *Appeal* reports are published bi-weekly.

Large, small or in the middle, every Cabrini Household's participation and gift is critical to meeting our collective Stewardship responsibility to the Diocese!
