This is an "off week" for reporting Bishop's Appeal statistics so the following data is of last week. Look to next week's bulletin for updated information.

- Total received to date: **\$23,995** or **66.3%** of goal (\$23,995/\$36,200);
- 234 Cabrini Households participating or 26.3% of Parish (234/890);
- Average gift stands at \$102.54;
- Awaiting response from 656 or 73.7% of the parish's households;
- Only \$12,205 (spread out among 656 Cabrini Households) is needed to meet our goal.

Special thanks and blessings to the wonderful group of 234 Cabrini Households who have brought us to twothirds of our goal amount. Through the efforts of our local Knights of Columbus, *Council #458*, a beautiful etching of the Holy Family will be with Mother Cabrini Parish for veneration during the weekend of July 29/30. The artist is Giovanni Balestra (1774-1842). A number of these images (based on an original painting by Giovanni Battista Salvi da Sassoferrato [1609 - 1685]) were blessed by Pope Francis on June 29, 2015 and are currently on pilgrimage from council to council throughout each K of C jurisdiction. It is the intention of the Knights that Catholic Families and their prayer lives be strengthened through such a visitation. July 23, 2017 SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Wisdom 12:13, 16-19

This passage from the Book of Wisdom addresses itself to God, giving praise and thanksgiving for his mercy.

Second Reading: Romans 8:26-27

Paul indicates that since people are, in general, unaccustomed to the manner of praying, of speaking directly to God, the Holy Spirit will intercede for them.

Gospel: Matthew 13:24-43

According to Matthew, Jesus speaks of the "reign of God" in three parables: the man who soweth good seed, the mustard seed, and the yeast. In each parable, Jesus demonstrates that once the "reign of God" had been established, it grew and spread.
