## WOW, 15 New Donors to Bishop's Appeal!

In response to my "reactivation letter," 15 new Cabrini Households have contributed to our Bishop's Appeal. As of Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>, here are our refreshed statistics. We hold our breath to hear from a good portion of those Cabrini Households who have yet to help the parish meet our fiscal stewardship to the Harrisburg Diocese. The good news thus far is as follows:

- 15 new gifts plus one "increase to original gift" received, totaling **\$958**, since the last report;
- Total received to date: **\$25,963**, **71.7%** of goal (\$25,963/\$36,200);
- **260** Cabrini Households participating or **29.2%** of Parish (260/890);
- Average gift stands at **\$99.86**;
- Awaiting response from **630** or **71%** of the parish's households;
- Only **\$10,237** (spread out among **630** Cabrini Households) is needed to meet our goal.

Special thanks and blessings to the wonderful "260 Cabrini Households" who have brought us to **71.7%** of our goal amount. If yours is one of the "630 Cabrini Households" who have not yet participated, won't you help us wrap up the appeal with your contribution?!? Those who already made their contribution await you and would love to see you come on board! And, you can put me out of this reporting job! Thanks! Updated *Appeal* reports are published bi-weekly.

#### **First Reading: Ezekiel 33:7-9**
