2017 Bishop's Appeal Breaks the 80% of Goal Mark!

As of December 31, 2017, we received 3 new gifts as well as 1 additional gift to an already received donation which help push Mother Cabrini Parish to slightly over 80% of our goal amount. We report the following updated statistics as of December 31st:

- 3 new gifts received since last report plus 1 add on gift, totaling **\$520.00**;
- Total received to date: **\$29,168.00** or **80.6%** of goal (\$29,168/\$36,200);
- **298** Cabrini Households participating or **33.5%** of Parish (298/890);
- Average gift stands at **\$97.88**;
- **592** or **66.5%** of the parish's households *did not make* their '17 stewardship gift;
- **\$7,032** (spread out among **595** Cabrini Households) will now have to be taken out of our ordinary and fund raising income to meet our goal.

Most sincere thanks, Kudos and blessings to the wonderful group of "**298 Cabrini Households**" who have brought us to **80.6%** of our goal amount. Your contribution brought us so tantalizing close to the finish line! Special thanks to those parishioners who even added to their original gift! If yours is one of the "**592 Cabrini Households**", *we missed your participation* in these final days of the '17 Appeal. **Even a \$25, \$20 or a \$10 gift would have helped enhance our statistics.** Now, we have to make up the shortfall from our regular income and fund-raisers.

It will take us a week or two to reconcile our financial Appeal numbers with those on record with the Diocese to guarantee accuracy at both ends. In a couple of weeks, a final report of '17 Appeal donors will be published in the parish bulletin. Once again, my heartfelt note of thanks and appreciation to the 298 Cabrini Households who participated and who got us to 80%!

JANUARY 14, 2018

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: 1 Samuel 3:3b-10, 19

This powerful story describes Samuel, who at the time was the servant of the high priest. The Lord called out to Samuel, who twice thought Eli had called him. They gradually realized that it was the Lord who called for him. So the third time Samuel answered and the Lord remained with Samuel as he grew.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20

Paul explains to the Corinthians that their body is a temple of the Holy Spirit. He tells them to avoid lewd conduct, and glorify God by keeping their bodies pure.

Gospel: John 1:35-42

John told two of his disciples that Jesus is the Lamb of God. They turned and followed him, immediately curious and attracted to him. Andrew told his brother Simon about Jesus. Simon also came to meet Jesus, who renamed him Cephas, or Peter.
