## 2017 Bishop's Appeal Breaks the 81% of Goal Mark!

We are in the tedious process of verifying our *2017 Bishop's Appeal* numbers with those on record with the Diocese. Thank you to the **1** new Cabrini Household which made a recent **\$25** gift to the *2017 Appeal* which in turned pushed us over the **81%** of Goal mark! As soon as we have an accurate accounting, we will share the final results and the list of all Cabrini households who have helped the parish meet its stewardship responsibility to the Diocese. Here is what we have for statistics as of now: **300 out of 890** Cabrini Households have participated (**33.7%**); **\$29,443** or **81.3%** of Goal raised; average gift stands at **\$98.14**; **590** Cabrini Households have not yet responded or **66%** of the parish community. Watch for the coming report insert. It will take another week or two of going back and forth with Harrisburg to verify the data. If you haven't yet made your *2017 Appeal* donation and wish to do so, please make your gift ASAP so we can include your household in the parish report. **FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**First Reading: Job 7:1-4, 6-7**

In this passage, Job laments the drudgery and pain all people sometimes experience in life. He talks of troubled days and restless nights. But he does mention that the days move along swiftly, which can remind us that our time here on earth is quite limited and should be well spent.

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 9:16-19, 22-23**

Paul explains to the Corinthians that he has no choice, but must preach the gospel. He tells of making himself all things to all people, in order to save some of them. He reminds them that he does this willingly, in the hope of sharing in the blessings of the gospel.

**Gospel: Mark 1:29-39**

Jesus cured Simon and Andrew's mother of a fever, then others with illnesses or demons came to see him. He cured those who were ill, and cast out the demons of the others. Then he went off and prayed alone until his followers sought him out. Jesus and his disciples then moved on to other villages to proclaim the good news.
