The parish builds its annual budget based on projected income and projected expenses. Shortfalls in any weekend collection income strains our ability to pay our regular occurring parish bills. Thank you and God bless all who support their parish, in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health and whether in town or not!

Update: Nearly 26% Participation for *Bishop's Appeal*!

As of May 29th, here is where we stand with our *Appeal* Stewardship Obligation to the Diocese:

- 3 new gifts/pledges received since last report, plus 1 “add to previous gift,” totaling \$245;
- 215 Cabrini Households have responded with their contributions;
- 25.6% Cabrini Household participation thus far, 215/841;
- \$22,688 collected in gifts and pledges;
- 67.5% of goal achieved to date, \$22,688/\$33,600;
- Only \$10,912 remains to reach our goal, spread out among 74.4% of the parish;
- Average gift, \$105.53;
- Waiting to hear from 626 Cabrini Households, 74.4% of the parish.

My thanks to the above group of 215 Cabrini Households who have helped our parish cross the TWO-THIRDS mark of reaching our goal. A call out to the 626 Cabrini Households who are still in the wings, contemplating their 2018 *Appeal* contribution. Come on board and help Mother Cabrini make its 2018 goal! It's a group effort. . . We've been doing so well up to this point, let's keep the momentum going!

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

First Reading: Exodus 24:3-8

Moses explained to the people the commandments he had received from God. Upon hearing them, the entire community immediately agreed they would do as God had told them. Moses then sacrificed young bulls and sprinkled the people with their blood, calling it the blood of the covenant they had made.

Second Reading: Hebrews 9:11-15

Jesus did not offer God the blood of sacrifices, but instead he offered up his own blood to cleanse all people of the transgressions they had committed under the first covenant with God. Christ instead brought a new covenant, which, if kept, would lead to eternal life.

Gospel: Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

Jesus sent two of his disciples to prepare the Passover supper. During the meal he blessed bread and offered it to them saying, "This is my body." He then offered them wine and called it his blood, "the blood of the covenant, to be poured out on behalf of many."
