Nearly 26% Participation for Bishop's Appeal!

This is an "off Week" for reporting our statistics, so as of May 29th, here is where we stand with our *Appeal* Stewardship Obligation to the Diocese:

- 3 new gifts/pledges received since last report, plus 1 "add to previous gift," totaling **\$245**;
- **215** Cabrini Households have responded with their contributions;
- **25.6%** Cabrini Household participation thus far, 215/841;
- **\$22,688** collected in gifts and pledges;
- **67.5%** of goal achieved to date, **\$22,688/\$33,600**;
- Only **\$10,912** remains to reach our goal, spread out among **74.4%** of the parish;
- Average gift, **\$105.53**;
- Waiting to hear from **626** Cabrini Households, **74.4%** of the parish.

Chocolate Egg News. . .

Believe it or not!, just last week, we received a final income check regarding our 2018 Easter Egg Fund-Raising Effort! With that check, we were able to crunch the numbers and here are the good results: All revenue for the 2018 Easter Egg Project - **\$11,892.91**; All expenses related to the project - **\$2,944.57**; 2018 Egg Project Net profit - **\$8,948.34**! This was an increase of **\$562.15** from last year. The increase was due to. . . tighter inventory control, carry over of supplies from the previous year and "opening of new markets" for our eggs. *Kudos! Thanks! and Applause!* to all those parishioners who gave so generously of their time and talent to all the many and varied tasks associated with the Easter egg project. TENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Genesis 3:9-15

God asked Adam why he ate the fruit from the forbidden tree. Adam blames his companion, who in turn blames a serpent. God then told the serpent it would be banned from other animals, and be an enemy of humanity.

Second Reading: II Corinthians 4:13—5:1

Paul describes our belief that “He who raised up the Lord Jesus will raise us up along with Jesus.” Although our bodies grow weaker, each day our inner strength grows. Paul also describes our burdens as light when compared to the eternal rewards we can attain.

Gospel: Mark 3:20-35

Some of the scribes felt that Jesus was possessed and claimed that he expelled demons with help from Satan. Jesus silenced them by asking, “How can Satan expel Satan?” Jesus also warned them that although many sins would be forgiven, blasphemy against the Holy Spirit would not. Jesus was then told that his mother, brother and sisters were asking for him. He asked, “Who are my mother and brother and sisters? Whoever does the will of God is brother and sister and mother to me.” This demonstrates Jesus’ deep love for all those who love God.
