## We're Getting There!: 69.7% of Goal Reached by 27% of Parish!!

As of June 25<sup>th</sup>, here are our refreshed *Appeal* data:

- 4 new gifts/pledges received since last report, totaling **\$165**;
- 227 Cabrini Households have responded with their contributions;
- 27% Cabrini Household participation thus far, 227/841;
- **\$23,408** collected in gifts and pledges;
- **69.7%** of goal achieved to date, **\$23,408/\$33,600**;
- Only **\$10,192** remains to reach our goal, spread out among **73%** of the parish;
- Average gift, **\$103.12**;
- Waiting to hear from **614** Cabrini Households, **73%** of the parish.

My thanks to the above group of 227 Cabrini Households who have helped our parish come to a whisker of the **SEVENTY PERCENT** mark of reaching our goal. A call out to the 614 Cabrini Households who are still in the wings, contemplating their 2018 *Appeal* contribution. Come on board and help Mother Cabrini make its 2018 goal! It's a group effort. . .
