## Diocesan Annual Campaign Report (The Former Annual Lenten Appeal)

This is an off week for reporting *Campaign* results. These statistics are as of May 13<sup>th</sup>. I express most sincere thanks to each of the 6 most recent Mother Cabrini Parish Households who responded with their contributions/pledges of \$570.00. Your participation and generosity is most heartening and inspiring. The updated figures are as follows:

- 98 Cabrini Households have participated or 11.8% (98/829) of our active registered Cabrini households;
- Total received in gifts and pledges \$12,591;
- Average gift as of this report is \$128.48;
- 98 Cabrini Households have brought us to 36.3% of goal (\$12,591/\$34,700).
- Please God, we hope to hear from the remaining 731 Cabrini Households (88.1% of the parish, (731/829) in the weeks ahead.

I voice my most sincere thanks to each of those 98 Cabrini Households who have brought us to over a third of the way to our 2019 *Campaign* goal. I appeal to all Cabrini households to join with your fellow parishioners to help the parish meet its stewardship responsibility to the Diocese. Every household's participation is critical. Sixth Sunday of Easter**

**First Reading: Acts 15:1-2, 22-29**

Some men informed the Gentiles that they must be circumcised if they wished to be saved, because of the Old Laws. Disciples then went forth to tell the Gentiles to honor only those rules which were strictly necessary, such as abstaining from eating meat sacrificed to idols and illicit sexual union.

**Second Reading: Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23**

John depicts Jerusalem coming out of heaven, sparkling with the radiance of precious jewels. Angels were stationed at each of its twelve gates, and each gate bore the name of one tribe of Israel. The city had no temple, because God was its temple. The glory and light of God and the Lamb also replaced their need for the sun.

**Gospel: John 14:23-29**

Jesus tells his disciples, "Anyone who loves me will be true to my word." For those who do honor his word, both Jesus and God will love them and stay with them always. He also tells them that God will send the Holy Spirit in his place to give them the instructions they will need. Jesus then tells them that peace is his farewell gift to them.
