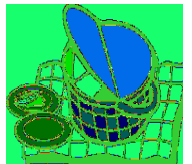

Diocesan Annual Campaign Report (The Former Annual Lenten Appeal)

With Fr. Martin being away this past week, there is not an updated report for the Diocesan Annual Campaign. Look to next week's bulletin for updated numbers.

1 Did You Know? . . . The former Bishop's Annual Lenten Appeal was renamed to "The Diocesan Annual Campaign" I ask that you please participate in this program to the best of your ability. The Diocese funds so many worthy charities which depend on this support. If you've misplaced your Campaign envelope, simply enclose your contribution in your own envelope but mark it: "**Annual Campaign**" and drop in the collection or at the parish office. - **98** Cabrini Households have participated or **11.8%** (**98/829**) of our active registered Cabrini households;
- Total received in gifts and pledges **\$12,591**;
- Average gift as of this report is **\$128.48**;
- **98** Cabrini Households have brought us to **36.3% of goal** (\$12,591/\$34,700).
- Please God, we hope to hear from the remaining **731** Cabrini Households (**88.1%** of the parish, (**731/829**) in the weeks ahead.

I voice my most sincere thanks to each of those **98** Cabrini Households who have brought us to over a third of the way to our 2019 *Campaign* goal. June 16, 2019 THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

First Reading: Proverbs 8:22-31
