## Diocesan Annual Campaign

This is an off week for reporting our Annual Campaign status. As of July 3<sup>rd</sup>, here is where we stand as a parish relative to the **2019 Diocesan Annual Campaign**: we have received **7** new contributions totaling **\$1,170**. I express most sincere thanks to each of the 7 most recent Mother Cabrini Parish Households who responded with their contributions/pledges. Your participation and generosity is most heartening and inspiring. The updated parish figures are as follows:

- **116** Cabrini Households have participated or **14%** (**116/829**) of our active registered Cabrini households;
- Total received in gifts and pledges **\$15,271**;
- Average gift as of this report is **\$131.65**;
- **116** Cabrini Households have brought us to **44% of goal** (\$15,271/\$34,700).
- Please God, we hope to hear from the remaining **713** Cabrini Households (**86%** of the parish, **713/829**) in the weeks ahead.

I extend my most sincere thanks to each of those **116** Cabrini Households who have brought us close to the **50%** mark of our 2019 *Campaign* goal. I appeal to all Cabrini households to join with your fellow parishioners to help the parish meet its stewardship responsibility to the Diocese. All monies collected through the Campaign, fund very important charitable works within the Diocese. So, every household's participation is critical. Any unpaid balance of the '19 *Campaign* will have to come out of our ordinary parish income. . . and that hurts the parish financially. *Large, small or in the middle, every household's gift and every household's participation is important to our common success.* My "Sincerest Thank You" to our **116** participants!!

**Orders must be received by Monday, August 12, 2019.** Your purchased tickets will be mailed, directly to the address you provide, on Tuesday, September 3, 2019. **All OIP Ticket orders must be prepaid.** And remember, all proceeds benefit Mother Cabrini.

The sub tickets can be used on ham & cheese, turkey & cheese, Italian, or tuna subs. The pizza tickets are good for a large cheese pizza. These specific subs start at \$6.29 and the pizzas start at \$12.29. By purchasing your tickets through Mother Cabrini, you are **saving** at least **\$1.29** per sub and **\$2.29** per pizza. Support Cabrini and stock up on your tickets - you can't beat these savings!

We recently received word from the Franciscan Sisters of St. Joseph (F.S.S.J.) Mother House in Hamburg, New York that Sr. Mary Helen Royack died peacefully on Friday, June 28, 2019 in the Colette Hilbert Care Community in the 87 year of life and the 66<sup>th</sup> year of her Franciscan religious vocation. Sister Mary Helen received a Bachelor's degree in Education from St. Francis College in Loretto, PA. Ministering to many educational fields, one was her tenure at St. Stephen's here in Shamokin, Sister also served as the school's principal. In 1992, Sister Mary Helen returned to Immaculata Academy to minister in the Alumnae Office. In February 2006, Sister Mary Helen joined the Sisters in the Colette Hilbert Care Community. Sister Helen will be remembered as a self-controlled and serious person who was trusting and easy to get along with. She was concerned about the well-being of others as witnessed by her good social relations. Sister Helen was interested in arts & crafts, travel, reading, and listening to music. She had a devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. After her funeral Mass in Hamburg, NY, she was buried at St.
