“Off Week” Report, Diocesan Annual Campaign

As of July 22nd, here is where we stand as a parish relative to the **2019 Diocesan Annual Campaign**: we have received **5** new contributions and **3** “add to my previous gift” donations totaling **\$515**. I express most sincere thanks to each of the **8** most recent Mother Cabrini Parish Households who responded with their contributions/pledges/additional gifts. Your participation and generosity is very much appreciated. The parish figures are as follows:

- **121** Cabrini Households have participated or **14.6%** (**121/829**) of our active registered Cabrini households;
- Total received in gifts and pledges **\$15,786**;
- Average gift as of this report is **\$130.46**;
- **121** Cabrini Households have brought us to **45.5% of goal** (\$15,786/\$34,700).
- Please God, we hope to hear from the remaining **708** Cabrini Households (**85.4%** of the parish, **708/829**) in the weeks ahead.

I extend my most sincere thanks to each of those **121** Cabrini Households who have brought us closer to the **50%** mark of our 2019 Campaign goal. I appeal to all Cabrini households to join with your fellow parishioners to help the parish meet its stewardship responsibility to the Diocese. All monies collected through the Campaign, fund very important charitable works within the Diocese. So, every household’s participation is critical. Any unpaid balance of the ‘19 Campaign will have to come out of our ordinary parish income. . . and that hurts the parish financially. *Large, small or in the middle, every household’s gift and every household’s participation is important to our common success.* My “Sincerest Thank You” to our **121** participants!! Orders must be received by Monday, August, 12, 2019. Your purchased tickets will be mailed, directly to the address you provide, on Tuesday, September 3, 2019. **All OIP Ticket orders must be prepaid.** And remember, all proceeds benefit Mother Cabrini.

The sub tickets can be used on ham & cheese, turkey & cheese, Italian, or tuna subs. The pizza tickets are good for a large cheese pizza. These specific subs start at \$6.29 and the pizzas start at \$12.29. By purchasing your tickets through Mother Cabrini, you are **saving** at least **\$1.29** per sub and **\$2.29** per pizza. EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY
IN ORDINARY TIME**

First Reading: Ecclesiastes 1:2, 2:21-23

"Vanity of vanities." Sometimes we may work for wealth, wisdom and knowledge only to discover that it has been left for someone who did not toil for it. The offering of our work, fatigue and pain, if not for God, can also be a kind of vanity.

Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11

Paul urges us to seek what is good and from God, encouraging us to put our minds on the spiritual. He reminds us that, as Christians, we have died with Christ and are hidden with Christ until his glory is once again revealed. We are all one in Christ.

Gospel: Luke 12:13-21

On being requested to settle a question of inheritance, Jesus heeds us to beware of all covetousness because our life does not consist on the wealth of possessions. Through the lesson of a parable Jesus reinforces this teaching, explaining that those who store up the treasures of wealth and possessions are not the richest in God's eyes.
