2019 Diocesan Annual Campaign Update

Gifts received by December 31, 2019

As of the last day of December, December 31st, 2019, we received **17 New Gifts** and **3 additional gifts** to already existing donations totaling **\$2,785.00**.

The data for the **2019 Diocesan Annual Campaign** are as follows: **160** Mother Cabrini households participated or **19.3%** of our parish register (**160/829**). Unfortunately, we have not heard from **669** Cabrini Households or **81%** of the parish.

\$20,471 has been raised of our **\$34,700** goal amount or **59.0%**.

The average gift stands at **\$127.94**.

The **\$14,229 Campaign shortfall** will have to come out of our ordinary/fund raising income.

If your household has not yet made a contribution to the 2019 Campaign, you still may do so. The parish would be most grateful for your participation.

First Reading: Isaiah 8:23—9:3

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:10-13, 17

Paul speaks to the Corinthians with both anger and indignation because they are quarreling among themselves as to whom they should show allegiance. Some wish to follow Paul; some, Peter; others Apollos; others, Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 4:12-23

Jesus begins his mission by going to Capernaum, fulfilling the prophecy of Isaiah. He selects Peter, Andrew, James and John as his disciples, inviting them to be "fishers of men."
